

Homestay Code of Behaviour Under 18 Students

All students under the age of 18 and their families must be aware that by choosing to study at CCEB, they must comply with very definite behaviour codes. All students who do not obey these rules will be counselled and if the behaviour continues, students may have their course cancelled.

Homestay families will advise CCEB when any of these rules are NOT adhered to.

Homestay Rules:

- Students must be respectful and obedient at all times of the Homestay family rules. If problems arise, the school's Dispute Resolution policy will be followed – please see staff at Reception. If the student's behaviour does not improve, the student may have their course and/or Homestay cancelled.
- Students must always let their host parent know where they are outside of normal school hours (8am -4.30pm weekdays), especially between 2:45pm-4:30pm in their free time.
- Students under 18 must have a contact phone number and give this number to their host parents.
- Students are never allowed to enter a licensed premises unless in the company of their guardian.
- Students are never allowed to stay in another house overnight. Students can however stay with another CCEB Homestay family with permission from the host family. The host family is to contact the other family and confirm that the student will be in their care and that they hold a current Working with Children suitability card. The host family must be given the full address and telephone number of the place where the student is staying.
- If a student changes their host family, they must have written permission from their parents, must discuss this with the Homestay Coordinator and advise the host family 2 weeks before they move.
- Students are to be driven to and from school by their host family unless CCEB has been given written permission from the parents.
- Students are NOT permitted to travel on public transport unless accompanied by their host family/ guardian or unless CCEB has been given written permission from the parents.
- Smoking is NOT permitted in Homestay.

Non-School activities:

- If the student has written permission from their parents to attend non-school activities in their own free time; like Bungy Jumping, Rafting, Sky-Diving, Scuba Diving and alike; on a weekend or after school hours, or to stay out later during the week/weekend, then these rules can be amended with written permission from their parents via email to the Director of CCEB.
